

GARBAGE & RECYCLE COLLECTION SERVICE

West Coast weekly garbage collection service:

Gormanston, Strahan and Zeehan	–	Tuesday
Queenstown	–	Wednesday
Rosebery and Tullah	–	Thursday

West Coast monthly recycling collection service:

Queenstown & Strahan	–	1 st Friday
Rosebery, Tullah & Zeehan	–	2 nd Friday

What can be put in the Wheelie Bin?

- Normal household waste
- Any solid non-toxic waste

Items must fit loosely in the bin so as to fall out easily when the bin is tipped up to empty

What can be put in the Recycle Bin?

- Milk Cartons
- Plastic Beverage Containers
- Paper, newspaper & Magazines
- Cardboard
- Steel/ Aluminum cans & Aerosols
- Glass

What can't be put in the Wheelie Bin?

- Hot ashes
- Oil, paint, chemicals, solvents or other liquids
- Heavy builder's rubble, car parts, large timber or metal pieces

What can't be put in the Recycle Bin?

- Food waste
- Polystyrene
- Mirrors
- Nappies
- Material/Fabric products
- Cement, dirt and rock
- Cigarette butts

Hints on how to prevent offensive odours in the Wheelie Bin

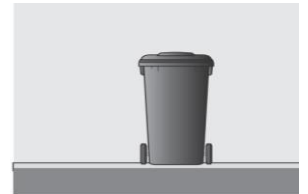
- Freeze waste food and place them in the bin just before collection, slowing bacteria that break food down
- Do not over fill the bin and ensure that the fly proof lid is properly closed
- Store bin in a cool shady area
- Use home composting
- Clean bin regularly

Reuse supermarket bags to contain kitchen scraps, grass clippings, vacuum cleaner dust etc to help keep your bin clean



Remember:

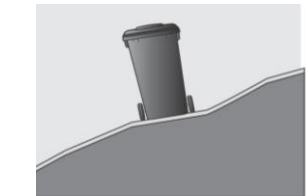
No additional bags or boxes will be collected



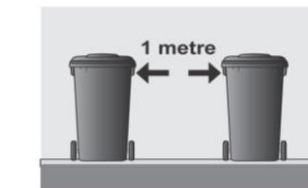
Do not place anything on top of your bin or lean any objects next to the bin



Do not over-fill your bin and make sure the lid is properly closed



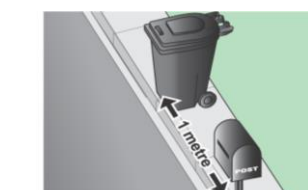
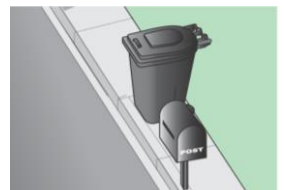
Do not place your bin on uneven ground



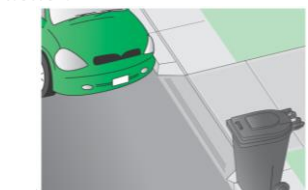
Do not place your bin within one metre or behind another bin



Do not place your bin under or next to a tree



Do not place your bin near a power pole, sign or obstruction



Do not place your bin behind a parked car
