TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND USE OF



MACQUARIE HEADS CAMPGROUND

Campers must register and pay fees onsite at Caretakers Residence or through the Council offices at 11 Sticht Street, Queenstown. Signing this agreement and/or camping in the Macquarie Heads Campground signifies your acceptance of the below conditions.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1 West Coast Council will allocate all vacant temporary sites on a first in first served basis. You may be asked to move or leave any site at any point for any reason, no compensation is payable. All bookings are nontransferable.
- 2 All vehicles brought into Macquarie Heads campground must be registered, roadworthy compliant and insured and must be parked within the designated site area only (not placed hard on the boundary). 1 caravan/motorhome per site only.
- 3 Sites allow for tents (not to be left when site is unoccupied), motorhomes (1), unmodified caravans (1) with soft or easily dismantled and removed hard annexes. No permanent fixtures are to be erected whatsoever.
- 4. Any animal brought into the campsite must always be under effective control of its owner.
- 5. One chemical toilet only is allowed per site, all grey water must be disposed of in the grey water disposal area, under no circumstances are they to be emptied anywhere else. No permanent structures are permitted.
- 6. You must comply with any notices and must immediately vacate the site as a result of an emergency.
- 7. Native vegetation is not to be damaged, any construction of any tracks on or around the site is not permitted nor is any activity which may damage, destroy or cause disturbance to any areas surrounding the site or impede public use.
- 8. All visitors are required to respect the rights of and not disturb other site users, with no loud noise between 10pm and 8am. The use of generators is not permitted during these hours.
- 9. You must leave the campsite clean and tidy and remove all rubbish.
- 10. Firearms and fireworks are strictly prohibited. Existing campfires are only allowed on non-fire ban days and are not to be used to dispose of rubbish. Building of new campfires is not permitted.
- 11. As required as part of the booking process, you must supply name, address, email & telephone numbers.
- 12. West Coast Council accepts no responsibility for loss or damage by fire, theft, accidents or otherwise, including acts of Mother Nature including damage or injury to any of your party, any persons including family, children, friends or other people visiting the campsite.
- 13. Council reserves the right to demand guests who contravene or breach these terms and conditions or, in any other way behave in a manner likely to cause distress or nuisance to other visitors, to immediately leave the campground and remove all property placed on site. Council's decisions are final on all matters.
- 14. Any damage or vandalism should be reported to the site caretaker (if on site), disruptive or dangerous behaviour should be reported to the Police.
